To get to Boltzmanngasse (UniVIE) you are quickest by foot.











To get to Boltzmanngasse (UniVIE) you have several tram options. You can take **tram 44** in the **direction Schottentor** for 3 stations until you arrive at **Lange Gasse**. There you can **switch to tram 5** in the **direction Praterstern S+U** for two stations until **Spitalgasse**. From there it is just a short walk to the institute.











To get to Boltzmanngasse (UniVIE) it's easiest if you take **tram 38** in the **direction Schottentor U** for 8 stations until you reach **Spitalgasse**. From there it is just a short walk to the institute.















Transportation in General

To plan your trip in Vienna, we recommend downloading the <u>WienMobil App</u> for **public transport** purposes. You can buy your public transport tickets directly in the app and it has accurate information on any possible malfunctions. Alternatively, you can also look up your destinations in Google Maps, or the <u>City Route planner</u>.

There are a lot of different ticket options. A one-way-ticket costs 1,20€ a **24-h-ticket is 8€** and a 48h-ticket is 14,10€.

If you want to stay longer and think about going to the museum, theater or sightseeing, a Vienna City Card or QueerCityPass might be of interest to you since it gives extra discounts on certain entry fees.

Most tickets can be bought directly in the subway, tram or bus you are using. Some can only be bought <u>online</u> (also in the WienMobil App) or in certain ticket shops.

If you are more comfortable taking a **car**, there is a <u>car sharing service</u> from the Vienna public transport as well. For personal drivers, apps like Uber are common, as well as different **taxi** services like <u>Taxi40100</u> for example. In case you want to take a taxi to/from the airport, there is usually an additional fee! You might get a better price if you use a special <u>airport taxi</u> for those cases.

If you arrive at the **airport** the simplest way into the inner city is usually the <u>City Airport Train</u>. There are alternative, cheaper routes by <u>Sbahn</u> or <u>bus</u>, but they take longer and you have to make sure to get the right ticket to cover the all the zones between the airport and the inner city.













Locations and Directions for Wednesday, 24th September 2025


On this day the Symposium is held at several locations.

Participants of the Active Bystander Workshop from ZARA meet in the seminar room 2.08. on the 2nd floor of the Institute for Quantum Optics and Quantum Information (IQOQI) at **Boltzmanngasse 3**.

To get into the building please ring the bell at "IQOQI Sekretariat 1", so someone can open the door for you.

After the workshop we will go **from Boltzmanngasse 3 to Gusshausstraße 27-29** for lunch and labtours at the **Photonics Intitute** (TU Wien).

We will take one of the many **trams to Schottentor**, like tram 41 for two stations. And there we can switch to **tram 1** in the **direction Stefan-Fadinger-Platz** for 7 stations until **Paulanergasse**.
















We will have <u>lunch at the new lab</u> at the Photonics Institute. To find the right room, it's easiest if you use the main entrance at Gusshausstrasse 27-29. Go down the hallway on the right, up the small stairs, then down the large staircase to the 1st lower ground floor (U1). From there follow the hallway to the left.

After the program at the Photonics Institute, we will go **from Gusshausstraße 27-29 to Stadionallee 2** for labtours and talks at the **Institute of Atomic and Subatomic Physics** (TU Wien).

Likely taking **subway U1** in the **direction Leopoldau** for 2 stations until **Stephansplatz**. And afterwards switching to **subway U3** in the **direction Simmering** for 5 stations until **Schlachthausgasse** and walking from there.
















Participants of the SFB Women's Mentoring Dinner will go from Stadionallee 2 to Franz-Josefs-Kai 2 afterwards.

For that we can take **bus 80A** in the **direction Praterstern S+U** for 4 stations until **Wittelsbachstraße**. Afterwards we switch to **tram 1** in the direction **Stefan-Fadinger-Platz** for 7 stations until **Salztorbrücke**.















Locations and Directions for Thursday, 25th September 2025

On Thursday our whole program will be held in the **Christian-Doppler lecture hall** (room **3355**) on the 3rd floor of the University of Vienna at **Boltzmanngasse 5**.

To find the lecture hall it is easiest, if you take the **entrance at Boltzmanngasse** 5, go straight forward and **find the big elevator** that takes you to the 3rd floor.

(Due to a construction site in our building at the moment the main entry at Strudlhofgasse is currently completely blocked and the other entrances might be a little out of view.)















After reaching the 3rd floor you can turn left at the hallway outside and walk to the end of it to find the lecture hall.





















Locations and Directions for Friday, 26th September 2025
